(C) RE: APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION #19/20-01 - GANN LIMIT APPROPRIATIONS SCHEDULES FOR 2018/2019 AND 2019/2020 (Attachment I)

Education Code section 42132 requires that school district governing boards adopt a resolution by October 31 to identify the District's 2018/2019 appropriations limit recalculation and the 2019/2020 estimated appropriations limit calculation. These limits permit government spending to increase at a rate no faster than inflation and the change of population. In the event that the District exceeds its limit, the proper form must be filed with the State within 45 days.
